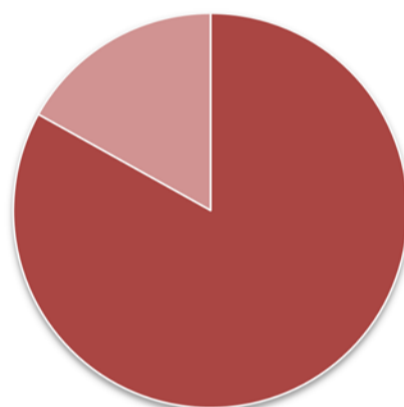
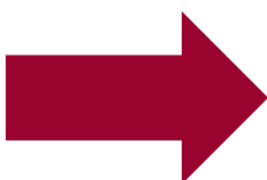
Estimated summarized statement of activities, fiscal year September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2012

Expense: \$930,107



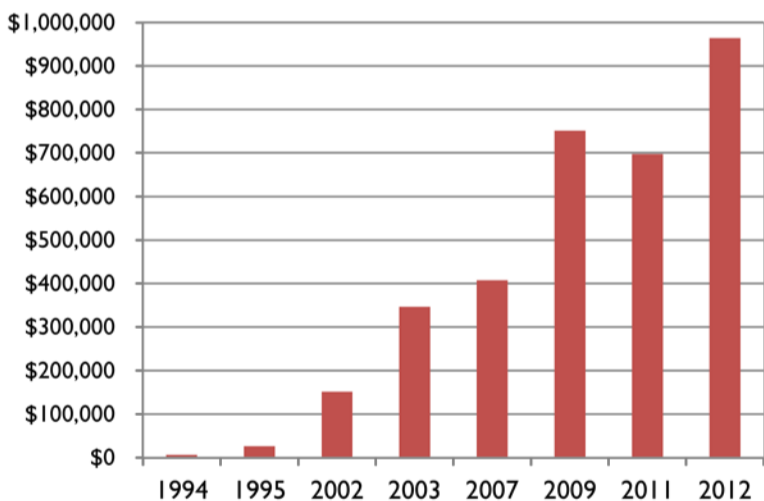
- Individual Donors (5.8%)
