DAILY LIFE

What to expect during the program:

- Homestays with local families
- High-speed internet access
- Guaranteed privacy and desk space for your classes
- Weekly Amizade signature course sessions (3 credits)
- Breakfast and lunch included, dinner on your own (lunch is the biggest meal in Bolivia, and most families have a small snack for dinner)
- Local support from Amizade site director
- Minimum of 10 hours of volunteer service per week (you can do more if you want!)
- Weekly excursions and activities
- Excursions may include: Cristo de la Concordia, La Cancha market, Inkallaqta Inca site

Fall 2021 Program dates:

- Application deadline: August 1, 2021
- Program start date: September 1, 2021
- Program end date: November 10, 2021

Fall 2021 Payment dates:

- \$300 deposit due within 2 weeks of acceptance, on or before August 1, 2021
- Full payment deadline: September 1, 2021*

PROGRAM FEES

Total cost: \$6,994* | Deposit: \$300

What's included:

- Airport pickup and dropoff
- Housing and some meals (breakfast and lunch)
- Weekly excursions and cultural activities
- Transportation to all activities and excursions
- Travel and health insurance
- Spanish classes (5 hours/week)
- 24/7 in-community support

Additional expenses (not included):

- Airfare to and from Cochabamba
- Visa fees: \$160 visitor visa required for US citizens, purchased on arrival in Bolivia.
- Passport fees (if applicable)
- Supplemental meals or snacks
- Personal spending money
- Daily transportation costs (if applicable)
- Any COVID-19 expenses: testing, PPE, etc.

- 18+ years old
- Pass a background check
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination
- Proof of health insurance, **US sites only**
- Enrollment in Amizade signature course (3 credits)
